Application Process

The application must be approved by the applicant's company Broker in Charge, or Designated Realtor. **All applications must be received by CRCBR no later than Thursday, November 24, 2006.**

Enrollment Fee

Upon acceptance into the program, participants or their firms will be required to pay an enrollment fee. This fee will cover the cost of the participant's involvement in the Leadership Program which includes attendance at specific CRCBR programs, CCP CoreConcepts Level 100 Series, monthly lunches, year end recognition, and more.
